



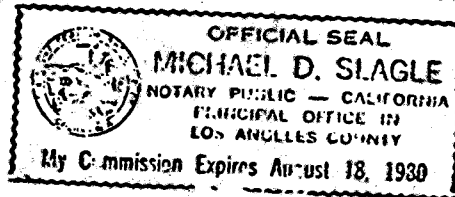

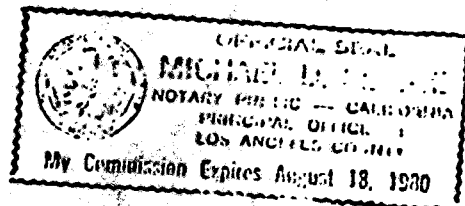

4. Richard Weigand worked standardly from 6:30 PM or so, to 10:30 or 11 PM. He also would come into the Mission in the afternoon from time to time.

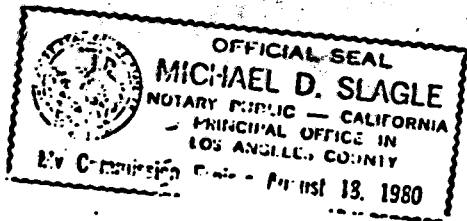
5. Richard Weigand was in Clearwater, Florida at the Church there, between the first week in August and the first week in September.

2. I am the wife of John Lake, who is the John Lake referred to in Russell Cicero's affidavit of May 19th, 1978, which was submitted before the U.S. District Court, Southern District of New York on May 19, 1978, in re Paula Tyler, a witness before the January, 1978, Additional Grand Jury.

3. Prior to, and since the FBI raid on the Church of Scientology on July 8, 1977, my husband John Lake and I have lived together in our home.

4. We shared an apartment with another person until approximately the end of August, at which time we moved to another apartment where we now live. We have lived at that new apartment since we moved there.

5. As we both work at the Church of Scientology as staff members, we are not often home during the day. We do return home at night, of course, to sleep, to eat, to dress, etc. This has been our normal procedure and we have not altered it at any time.

## AFFIDAVIT

I, Cargill P. Boyd of 500 West End Avenue, New York City, N.Y., 10024, being of sound mind and being duly sworn, hereby depose and say:

That on 17 March 1978, this Mission of the Church of Scientology, located at 500 West End Avenue in New York City was visited by two FBI agents.

On entering, one of them introduced himself to the receptionist as Russ and asked to see Paula Tyler on a personal matter.

When I asked them the purpose of their visit they insisted that it was a personal matter and they could only speak to Paula. After I repeated the same question three times Bob asked if I was Irving Paiewonsky and when I answered negatively, he said he would speak to Irving. When I refused to allow that to occur, with a nod from Bob, Russ pulled out his badge and said that they were FBI agents and had a subpoena for Paula Tyler.

When I stated that I could not allow a subpoena to be served on Church premises I was told that I was obstructing justice and the implication was clear that I might be in quite a bit of trouble.


Russ then left to call Denise Cote (their superior) and returned to say that Denise wanted to take action against me unless I allowed the subpoena to be served. This statement was contradicted a few minutes later when Russ told Bob that Denise had been in court and he had not been able to reach her.

Although I have no training in legal matters, I believe it is illegal to enter Church premises or any private property under false pretenses; and clearly the reluctance of Russ and Bob to state that they were from the FBI seems odd and deceitful. And the lies that were told (as above) seem stupid in the extreme.

It is totally beyond my understanding how two members of a group that we look to to uphold justice and to honor the law could enter a Church and tell lies for apparently selfish purposes and then use threats after their lies have not produced the desired results.

I am not proud to state this but I was very scared in confronting these men and it seems unreasonable that my government should employ people who would intentionally intimidate me when I have done no wrong.

All the foregoing is true and correct and I do so attest upon penalty of perjury.

Richard Wright are at Fifield Manor, eight-story, 500-600 room building, formerly a hotel, located in Los Angeles, California. John Lake is at Cedars-Sinai Complex, formerly a 6,000 room hospital, in Los Angeles, California. F.B.I. Agents have been unable to gain access to either of these residences in order to effect service. Henning Heldt, and Irone Mele, two officials of the Church of Scientology residing in Los Angeles, remained in their private residences refusing to answer the door for a period of days in October of 1977, after the F.B.I. tried to serve them with subpoenas. The F.B.I. finally served each of these individuals after waiting outside the residences for an extended period of time; two days in the case of Mr. Heldt and one week in the case of Ms. Mele.

4. Finally, Agent Varley told me on May 15, 1978, that Robert Sarno, an attorney for the Church of Scientology in California, had initially offered to make available members of the Church for whom the Government indicated it had subpoenas. Two days after his offer, attorney Sarno indicated that he would be unable to make his clients available to accept service of subpoenas.
