(WDC), for lengthy periods, late at night, under false pretenses. It is unknown what they were copying, but investigation has developed that they may have entered the locked office of [redacted]

AUSA DON CAMPBELL requested on 8/12/76, that the FBI Laboratory Division conduct an examination of the lock on [redacted] Office door to determine whether it has been tampered with.

REQUEST OF THE BUREAU

Advise WFO whether such an examination is possible and, if possible, advise whether laboratory personnel are available to examine the lock on Room 3430D, United States District Courthouse, Washington, D.C.

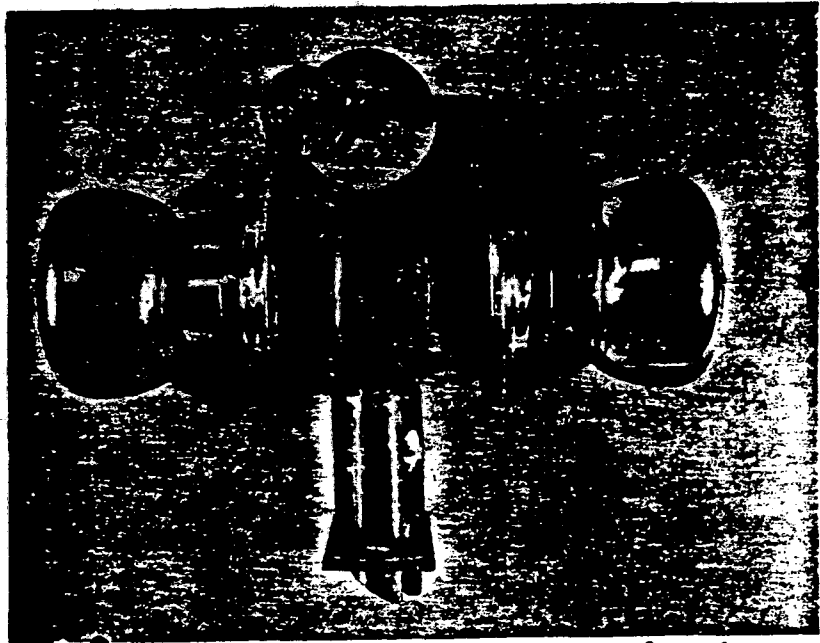
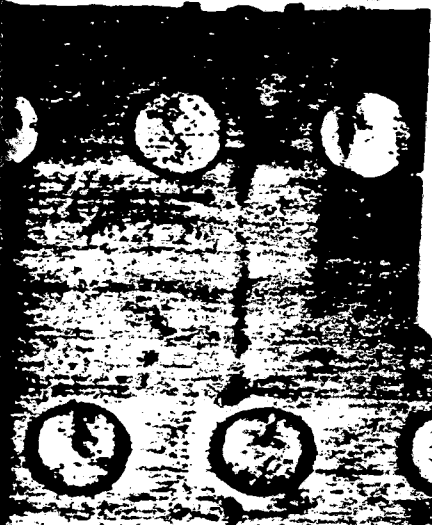
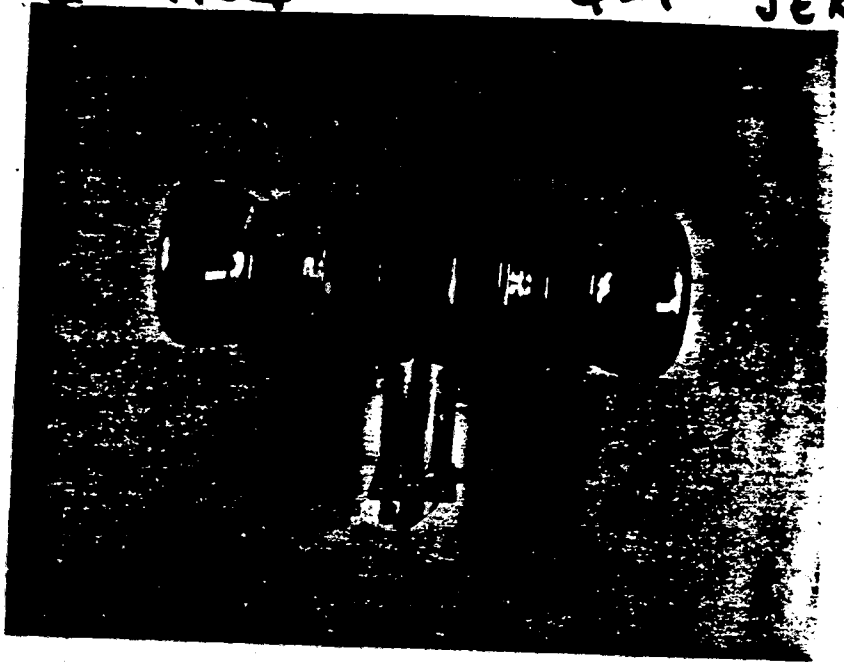
