choir will provide the music.

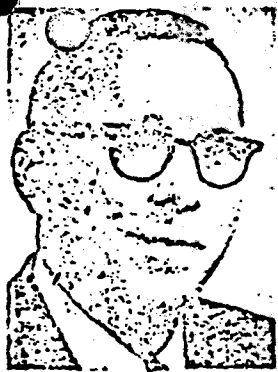
At 4 p.m. Sunday, a reunion service and
reception will be held. Former pastor, the
Rev. Lowell Droits of Chicago, will speak
and an anniversary-reunion choir will
sing. Former choir members who would
like to sing, led by a former choir director,
Bert Carlson with Mrs. Harry Clauson at
the organ, are invited to be at the church at
3 p.m. The Rev. Mr. Johnson says he hopes
former members and friends of the church
will be present for the service and for the
reception to follow in the church fellowship
hall.

The church actually began before 1878
with the people meeting in their homes.
Later that year a union hall on Davis St.
was rented for \$5 a month for meetings. In
1891 the church was organized formally
and in 1895 the congregation moved to the
Benson Av.-Clark St. site. In 1905 the
present site at Church and Oak was
secured, and the church was built and
dedicated in 1911.

In addition to the Rev. Mr. Johnson and
the three returning pastors, the church has
been served by 10 other ministers. They
were Otto Hogfeldt, 1890-92; C. J. Larson,
1892-95; Aaron Anderson, 1895-1900; John
Gustafson, 1901-01; Oscar G. Larson, 1904-
06; John Anderson, 1906-13; J. W. Carlson,
1913-26; Clarence A. Nelson, 1926-29; Paul
E. Palmquist, 1930-36; and Frederick E.
Pamp, 1937-51.

Scientologist unit tells probe of FBI

The National Commission on Law
Enforcement and Social Justice (NLEJ),
sponsored by the Churches of Scientology,
has turned its attention to the FBI.

A national campaign was launched by
NLEJ to locate victims of what it terms
FBI abusive practices. The commission
says it is investigating unlawful refusals
by the FBI to release files under the
Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), the

act enabling citizens to obtain and review
government files.

Floyd Saderlund, spokesman for the
Illinois Regional Office of the NLEJ
located in Evanston, says, "We are in-
vestigating instances where the media
have been refused files under act by the
FBI to thwart investigative reporting."

The Freedom of Information Act is the
only tool to correct this.

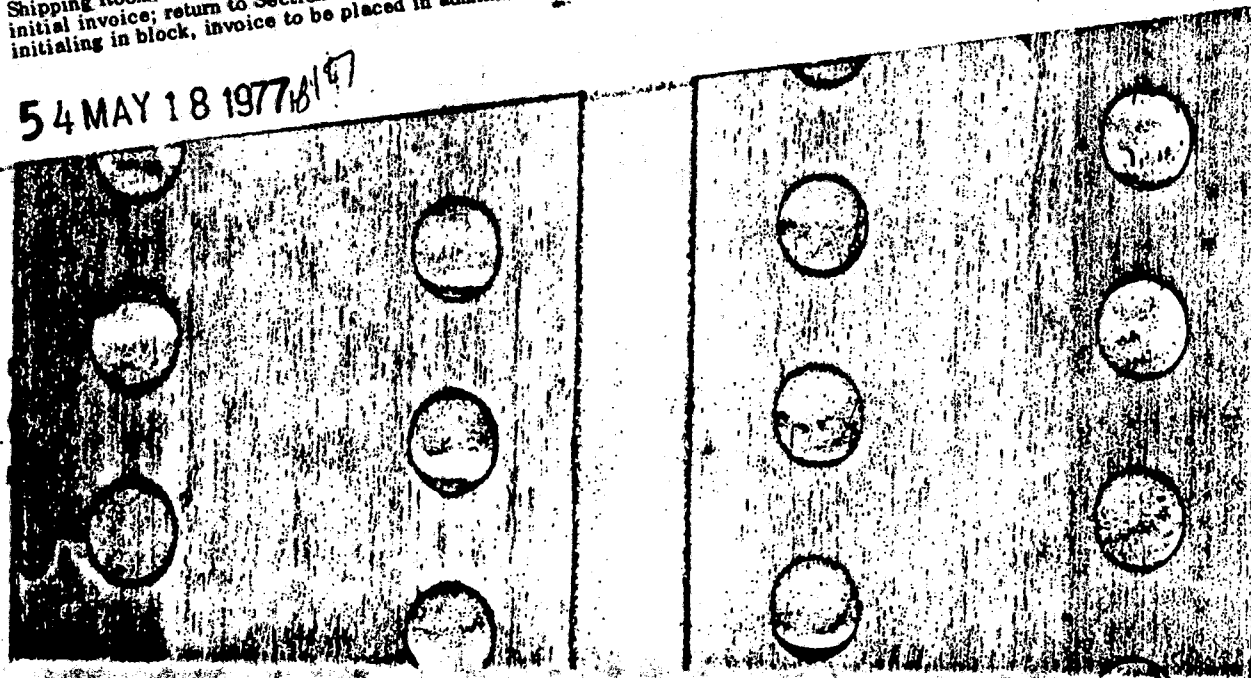

Enclosed for the Bureau are 5 copies of LHM dated and captioned as above.

Note that letter from CIC mentioned in enclosed LHM was classified confidential. All information concerning this matter appears in Seattle file 100-21344-5, 6 and 7. Note that in inner-office memorandum, dated 10/6/51, recommending no further investigation, it was pointed out that one of the heads of the Dianetics Clinic was HARVEY JACKINS and that the FBI had been informed that DAVE CYSEWSKI was also active in the organization.

In addition to information in LHM, it would appear probable that some of the information appearing in Bureau letter to Kansas City, dated 10/16/61, under caption, "Alleged Communist Infiltration into 'Dyanetics' School, Wichita, Kansas, IS - C" was furnished to the Seattle Police Department along with information from a copy of a letter from JOHN

There is no notation, or closing communication in file; however, the above information was furnished by Phoenix in response to Seattle letter to Phoenix, dated 9/13/63, under the caption, "L. RON HUBBARD, Police Cooperation"; Seattle file 62-2556, Phoenix file 105-117. Seattle Police Department was at that time conducting a homicide investigation relative to the murder of WILLIAM J. FISK, termed in file as Head of the Church of Scientology in the State of Washington. (S)(u)

By letter dated September 7, 1951, the officer in charge of the 115th CIC Detachment, Intelligence Field Office #3, 208 James Street, Seattle, Washington, requested to be informed if the Federal Bureau of Investigation had conducted, or contemplated conducting an investigation of the Dianetic Clinic, Seattle, because of information received that the Clinic was presided over by a Communist Party member and further infiltrated by other Communist Party members. In written response, September 14, 1951, it was indicated that a preliminary inquiry was being made to determine if sufficient basis to conduct a full scale investigation existed. It was noted that all pertinent information in Seattle FBI files had recently been furnished to a representative of that office. The nature of this information was not indicated, nor is the representative identified. (X)(u)

On October 6, 1951, it was recommended that no investigation of the Dianetic Clinic, Seattle, be conducted since it appeared there was insufficient infiltration into the organization by members of the Communist Party to merit such investigation. No investigation was conducted. (X)(u)

On November 3, 1966, [redacted] of Seattle Office of Internal Revenue Service, advised the Seattle Office of the FBI that his office was conducting background investigation relative to the Church of Scientology in connection with a Court of Claims action pertaining to its exemption status.

[redacted] was advised that the Seattle Office has never conducted an investigation on this organization but that the Seattle Police Department had reported the shooting of WILLIAM J. FISK, Pastor of the Church of Scientology, by an irate husband. He was informed that the Hubbard Association of Scientologists International in Phoenix, Arizona, might be the parent organization of the church.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.
