

In response to a court order issued by Chief United States District Court (USDC) Judge WILLIAM BRYANT, Washington, D. C. (WDC), on July 27, 1977, evidence seized July 8, 1977, while executing a search warrant on the Founding Church of Scientology, 2125 S Street. N.W. WDC, was scaled by Special Agents (SAs) and in the office of Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) HENRY F. SCHUELKE, III, Room 3136 C, USDC, WDC. The evidence consisted of one box of original and four Xerox copies of stolen government documents, two boxes of the original copies of the remaining documents and six boxes containing four Xerox copies of the remaining documents. These documents were left in AUSA SCHUELKE's
